Believing in a God with whom all things are possible!




Almost every day we are confronted with the impossible, as parents plead with us to rescue their addicted sons.






Ronnie Crocker 15 Years of Addiction/ Headed to prison



Rickey Hice 1 Month Before Project Rescue!




"The things which are impossible with men are possible with God" (Luke 18:27)
