

As the saying goes, "Desperate times call for desperate measures!"

A group of doctors at the Rockefeller Neuroscience Institute, funded by the National Institute on Drug Abuse, are drilling a hole into the brains of addicts to insert probes! Their frantic hope is to find a cure for the sickness of addiction!



At Project Rescue we see no need to drill a hole in the skull of our members to restore their addicted minds:

1. We show them how God designed the way their brain functions (Romans 7:22).

2. We teach them how destructively addictive sin is and how it hijacks their brain's reward system (Romans 7:23).

3. We explain how Jesus' sacrificial role (Romans 8:1) can ease a guilty conscience.

4. Finally, we reveal how the Holy Spirit, through His Word, can help heal and restore an addicted brain (Romans 8:2)!

Yes, instead of drilling holes in our members' heads, we encourage them to resist "the law of sin" and submit to "the law of the Spirit."

"There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death." Romans 8:1,2

Physical Needs We Provide

We provide housing, food, clothing, and transportation. We help them find employment to become financially independent.



Hero House has 3 apartments with 8 rooms for members.

Attached to the main house are 3 apartments with 6 rooms for members.

Apartments 4-7 have 10 rooms for members.

25 men are presently participating in Project Rescue.



Hope House (4 rooms) and Help House (4 rooms) are a quarter of a mile from our main campus.



Our cook, Aurora Delgado, gives the 25 members something to look forward to when they get off work! Food is one of the most important things to an addict in recovery! Thank you sister Delgado!

Ronnie has filed for a Trademark on the term Neurospiritual.



On Wednesday mornings they attend a class at Beltline with Steve Smith and Trae Durden; on Wednesday evenings a class at the Madison church with David Hargett; and on Sunday afternoons an AA meeting at the Beltline church with Rick Earwood.

8 Members Quit Smoking this year!

To close our Sunday evening graduation ceremony, minister Steve Smith led a prayer for all of our members and their families!



Our members must endure daily mental, emotional and spiritual struggles: In addition to our 1-year graduates, Zach has been in the program 289 days; Josh (263); Jon (213); Joseph (208); Hayden (206); Greg (187); Paul (158); Zach (138); David (115); John (99); Kirk (96); Dustin (83); Joshua (73); Corey (61); Nathan (59); Eddie (59); Lucas (46); Brian (43); and Justin has 26 days in the program!



41 men entered PR so far this year. Thirtysix of these 41 are continuing. This is an 87.80% success rate.

The primary reason for our positive success rate is that we are a Bible based recovery program and we use the church for follow-up!

56% success rate in 2018



50 men entered PR in 2018. 28 out of these 50 members were continuing at years end.

60.14% success rate in 2019

47 members entered PR in 2019. 29 of these 47 members were continuing at years end.

71.66% success rate in 2020

60 members entered PR in 2020. 43 of these 60 members were continuing at years end.

74.13% success rate in 2021

58 members entered PR in 2021. Forty-three of these 58 members are continuing.

87.80% success rate so far in 2022

41 members entered PR so far in 2022. Thirty six of these 41 members are continuing.
