Project Rescue Organization & Hierarchy

The organization of Project Rescue has grown over the last 9 years in Alabama.

We consider ourselves a work of the churches of Christ. Elders and preachers send members of their congregations to us for addiction recovery. As we house, feed, manage, and minister to their son, we are serving a man's parents.

Project Rescue could be compared to a Children's Home or Christian University. These institutions are not under an eldership, but they are supported by Christians and churches of Christ.

We are a Tax Exempt Non-Profit 501c3 corporation.

We have a Board of Directors.

Our Board of Directors appointed an Executive Committee to oversee the daily operation and management of the Project Rescue Program.

The Executive Committee has appointed a Director to carry out the management of the program members, staff, volunteers, grounds, and facilities. A Program Manager assists the Director.

To effectively manage an addiction recovery program, both recovering addicts and non-addicts are needed. The non-addicts must supervise the recovering addict staff members. The recovering understand the deceitfulness of addiction.
