History: Project Rescue was established in 1989. The residential program began in 2007 in South Georgia. In that same year Project Rescue became a 501c3 non-profit corporation. In 2011, the program moved to Alabama.

Facilities: We enjoy a main house and twelve apartments on 19 ½ acres in Priceville Alabama. We can accommodate up to 24 program members. We have designated 5 rooms for this Employee Assistance Program..

Executive Committee: Three capable retired business men oversee the day-to-day operation of the program.

Onsite Management: Ronnie Crocker (30 years) and Jason Cagle (8 years) have the essential experience to manage an addiction recovery program! They live onsite among the program members.

2019 Success Rate: Last year we housed, fed and managed 47 recovering addicts. Twenty-Nine of these men are continuing in their recovery. This is a 61.70% success rate.

Overall Success Rate: Thirty-Eight of our 52 members who completed 6-months are continuing (73.07% success rate). We enjoy an 83.78% success rate for our 1-year graduates, as 31 out of 37 are continuing to live clean & sober lives.

OutPatient Recovery Program



This OutPatient program is for the man who is still functional...

- 1. He does not need to have his social, travel and financial freedom totally restricted.
- 2. He does not need to be detoxed.
- 3. He has his own safe place to reside.
- 4. He has transportation for work, meetings, etc.

We recommend 6-months for the duration of this OutPatient Program. We will work with the program member's family to resolve the length of his program.

Our objective is to teach the program member how to reduce his drug urges and resist daily temptations as he lives in the community. He must learn how to be content without a drug or a drink! Then he will become a good father, husband, son, and employee!!

In OutPatient, the level of his social, travel and financial freedom will be determined by his family as they consult with Project Rescue staff.

OutPatient Recovery Program



The first month of OutPatient will be a period of stabilization:

- 1. He will be under A to B Rule to and from work.
- 2. He will not be allowed to have any form of cash.
- 3. He will not have contact with friends.
- 4. He will be subject to drug tests more frequently.

He will be monitored by Project Rescue staff and administered random drug and alcohol tests. A relapse will result in tightening his restrictions until he is able to resist using.

He will attend nightly addiction recovery support classes on our campus in Priceville. He will also attend Sunday morning church services with other Project Rescue members. He will attend a 1-on-1 session with a minister twice a week. Professional counseling will be available.

\$200 a month will support a man in our OutPatient Program. It will cover his supervision, drug testing, and some professional counseling.
