Our 1-year program consists of stages of freedom and tests:

- 1. A new member's daily schedule consists of two Bible classes, 1-on-1 time with a minister or counselor, recreation, community service work, appointments, and all church services.
- 2. After 30 days a member gets a job in the community. He then attends a nightly Bible class and weekly 1-on-1 session and all church services. The goal is for him to find a job he loves, which will enable him to become financially independent of his family.
- 3. After 90 days he gets a debit card to make his own purchases. He keeps his receipts.
- 4. After 6 months, he takes control of his finances. He is also given more social and travel freedom. When he completes 6 months, he moves to Hope House, which is \$300 less for his housing and food.
- 5. After 9 months he moves into his own apartment on OutPatient.
- 6. If during any of the above stages he relapses, he has to start all over in the program.
- 7. He graduates in 1 year.

According to James 5:19,20, we serve as a bridge back from the far country: "Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins."
