

# **Our 1-year program consists of stages of freedom and tests:**

1. A new member's daily schedule consists of two Bible classes, 1-on-1 time with a minister or counselor, recreation, community service work, appointments, and all church services.
2. After 30 days a member gets a job in the community. He then attends a nightly Bible class and weekly 1-on-1 session and all church services. The goal is for him to find a job he loves, which will enable him to become financially independent of his family.
3. After 90 days he gets a debit card to make his own purchases. He keeps his receipts.
4. After 6 months, he takes control of his finances. He is also given more social and travel freedom. When he completes 6 months, he moves to Hope House, which is \$300 less for his housing and food.
5. After 9 months he moves into his own apartment on OutPatient.
6. If during any of the above stages he relapses, he has to start all over in the program.
7. He graduates in 1 year.
