Some ask, "Why is there a program fee?"

Program fees are necessary for offsetting our monthly overhead expenses.

When a member's monthly program fees are spread over a 1-year period, the average is \$933 a month per member. Therefore, with an average of 15 members, we receive a total of \$13,995 a month in program fees.

A little over \$30,000 is a conservative estimate of our total monthly expenses.

This is why we are so thankful for the financial help we receive from Christians and churches. For this makes up the monthly deficit, so we can meet our expenses.

Most For Profit addiction recovery programs are \$28,000 for 30 days.

Because we are ministering to Christians, we try to keep the program fees as low as possible.

We try to get help from the family's home congregation to cover the member's program fees for the first three months.

Program fees cover housing, housing needs, food, and local transportation.

\$2000 is required when the program member arrives.

\$1000 covers month two.

\$1000 covers month three. .

At month four, the program fee is reduced to \$800 a month. We help the program member find a job. By his fourth month, he is expected to be working and supporting himself in the program.
