

# Second Six Month Rules

1. Your Finances are turned over to you. You are not allowed to have cash on property. You must have a budget and stick to it. You must keep an up to date record of your deposits and spending. You must keep a zero balance with Project Rescue. If you go into the red, you lose your financial freedom, and you turn over your pay card, and/or turn in your checks. When you get caught up, you get everything back. You must turn in one fourth of your program fee, phone line fee, ext. every week, if it is not already there.
2. You are off of A to B. Project Rescue vehicles are always under A to B. Therefore, you must A to B when you are travelling in a Project Rescue vehicle. You need verbal permission from Jason each time you use a PR vehicle.
3. You are required to listen to Ronnie's morning devotionals (5 minutes) on way to work or in the mornings.
4. Curfew at 11pm. Call Jason and ask verbally if you are going to be out past 11pm.
5. You can stay out overnight with family an average of two nights a week. Additional nights for holidays and special occasions. You must let Jason know verbally when you are staying out, and who you are staying with. You must send a Group (Cecil and Jason) text when you leave on an overnight visit, stating when you will return.
6. You must continue to attend all classes and 1-on-1 sessions. You must verbally ask Jason for permission to miss a class or 1-on-1 session.
7. You need to let Jason know which church you want to regularly attend on Sundays and Wednesdays. Then, if you are going to attend a different church, you must let Jason know verbally.
8. In your 7<sup>th</sup> month, you must become involved and active (benevolence, Young Adult groups, serving in worship, Bible classes, etc.).
9. At 9 months, you must find an Accountability Friend who lives in the area where you plan to live when you graduate. This must be a man who is not a family member. This man will hold you accountable. He will also drug/alcohol test you if necessary.
10. You are allowed to be friends and enjoy social activities with godly Christian women. Fornication is considered the same as a relapse. You are not allowed to stay overnight with a woman friend.
11. You are allowed to be on social media. No pornography, vulgarity, profanity, etc. All Project Rescue internet is for staff and for the cameras. You are allowed to get your own internet and cable TV.
12. Two days a week, you must meet (on-site) with a new program member for 15 minutes. Text Jason after meeting.
