When a man arrives, he is not allowed to travel anywhere by himself.

We drive him to and from work, church, shopping, and all appointments.

Members must obey the A to B rule when they travel from one place to another. This is sending a text to the manager each time they travel from one place to another.

When a man completes 30 days working a strong spiritual program, he is allowed to drive his car, only, to work and home. In time, if he is working a strong spiritual program, he may get more traveling freedom.

Some members are required to have a GPS – Starter Interrupter on their vehicle. This enables us to know their location, and if they relapse their starter can be turned off by a click of a computer mouse.

When vehicles are donated to us, we allow some members to buy them and pay them off at \$100 a month.
